The ARRIse Program will be accepting submissions starting May 17, 2021, and will continue selecting projects over the coming years in an ongoing effort to uplift the Asian film and TV industry. Application is open to filmmakers, 18 years of age or above, who are citizens of select countries or cities within the East Asia Pacific region. Applicants must also have key creative roles in the project submitted—



director, producer, or cinematographer. Films may be in narrative or documentary format across all genres, in English or Non-English with subtitles.
